**Below are temporary rules for guests the Classic Course at Otsego Resort.
These measures have been put in place to protect you, the staff and the
community.**

These rules are in effect from May 1st - until further notice.

If you are sick or are feeling sick, please do not come to the golf course.

- **Advance tee times are mandatory.** No exceptions. Hours will be limited (8am-6pm)
- **Online reservations and prepayment is required for all golf rounds.** You may also call the pro shop at 989-732-5181 to arrange tee times and prepayment.
- Please arrive 10-15 minutes before your tee time. Please do not show up early.
- The Resort's pro shop and bar/grill are now open
- Check in for your tee time at the pro shop door located down by the roundabout.
- A scorecard and pencil will be issued at check in. Scoring should be done by one person for the group so only one person touches the card and pencil.
- On the course, practice social distancing (stay at least 6 feet away from others).
- There will be no rakes on the course. Please use your feet to smooth the sand.
- Please replace divots when possible.
- The hole will be turned upside down so no balls will actually hit the bottom of the cup.
- Take advantage of the 2019 USGA rules change regarding leaving the pin in. Please leave the pin in place when putting. Please do not touch the flag stick.
- Do not pick up playing partners' clubs or balls.
- Forego the traditional post-round handshake. Use your imagination as to how to thank your playing partners for the game.
- Following your round, we ask that you depart the facility promptly.
- In the event of a weather/lightening delay please take shelter in your car to avoid congregating

Food & Beverage Service

Food or beverage service will be available in the pro-shop. The beverage cart will be available depending on the number of rounds.

Pro Shop

The pro shop will be open to limited number of people.

Driving Range & Practice Greens

The driving range and practice greens will now be available.
